



# Congratulations on your new sail!

## Tips

- for the prevention of mildew and cleaning of your sail:

### **Never leave wet sails furled or packed for more than a few days**

The moisture will cause mildew and that can be very hard to clean. Whenever you have the chance wash your sail with sweet water and dry out. Saltwater has a strong hygroscopic effect and hardly dries completely when the sails are furled or packed for more than a few days.

### **Use warm water or lemon solvent to clean your sail**

You can get rid of most stains by using a soft brush. Never use any chemical solvents or detergents because they may destroy the material integrity of your sail.

### **Hand in your sail for annual washing and/or storage**
